BELONG (JOHN 3:16)

As a biker, everywhere we go we have a sense of belonging with other bikers. Jesus came so that you can have a sense of belonging with God. The Bible says, "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

IMPOSSIBLE (ROMANS 3:23; ROMANS 6:23)

A biker can spot an "imposter" a mile away. Similarly, many people fake a relationship with Christ. They think that by being a "good person" they can have a relationship with God. It is impossible to come to God simply by "being good." The Bible states, "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God...and the wages of sin is death."

KNOW (1 PETER 3:18; ROMANS 5:8)

You can know God more confidently than you know your bike, more intimately than you know any human. God's Word tells us that "Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God." Did you know that "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

ETERNAL (JOHN 10:10; JOHN 14:3)

Riding a bike brings a rush of adrenaline; it provides a thrill that only a biker can understand. And yet, this excitement is pale in comparison to the joy in knowing Christ. Eternal life is not only a promise of heaven, but also a promise to have meaning and joy in this life. Jesus said, "I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly." But, just as all rides one day come to an end, so will your ride on this earth one day end. Jesus promises you, "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to myself; that where I am you may be also."

RECEIVE (ROMANS 10:9-10)

How can you have this free gift of eternal life? Repent and turn away from your sins and receive Jesus by placing your trust in him. The Bible promises, "That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."
