Area WMU Work—The Mississippi Baptist Convention Board has divided Mississippi into nine areas to facilitate the work of each department. Work in each WMU area is led by a coordinator and associate coordinator. Special Day funds assist areas in hosting training, fellowship, and motivational meetings. Assistance may also be provided for special projects.

Scholarships—Special Day funds provide annual scholarships for Mississippi Baptist students at Southern Baptist seminaries, for missionary kids attending Mississippi Baptist colleges, and for students in overseas seminaries. Students must meet qualifications set by the Mississippi WMU Executive Board.

Missionary Appointees—The Special Day Offering allows Mississippi WMU to present each Mississippi missionary appointee a monetary gift, which they usually use to buy a special piece of equipment to take with them. It becomes a reminder of the love of Mississippi WMU for her missionaries.

Missionary Kids Love Gifts—Children of missionaries usually come to the states to attend college. Special Day funds provide MKs with a love give, according to the requirements set by the Executive Board of Mississippi WMU.
