TEACHING SCRIPTURE IN SCHOOLS

What a great opportunity we have in Sydney, Australia, to go and teach scripture in public schools! Today, less than 2% of the people attend an evangelical church, whereas 50 years ago the number was 40%. Because the government has recognized a moral decline in the population, they are allowing and even encouraging evangelical volunteers to teach the Bible in the public schools, elementary age through high school.

Missions Mobilization is partnering with Life Church in Sydney to send volunteers to teach scripture lessons in public schools. Volunteers are needed to teach six months to one year, ideally from late January through the first of December (10 month time frame) or July through July for a full year. The ability to obtain a long-term visa, however, may limit the length of stay. The age of volunteers considered are those having completed one year of college through older adults.

Bible teachers are expected to teach multiple classes every week while building relationships and helping students connect with local church ministries. They will also be involved in some Life church ministries with youth and children.

The cost of this mission is flexible, but \$6,000 should cover food, transportation and spending while living in Australia for the year. Missions Mobilization and evangelical churches in Australia are partnering to provide airfare, volunteer mission insurance and housing.
