## Q & A

### **What if I use a PO Box?**

For the site to generate a prayer list, it must be based off of a physical delivery address used by USPS. However, we are able to provide a list of households with PO Boxes to prayer volunteers who are home bound to pray for these families by name.

### **What is your Privacy Policy?**

Your personal information is not shared by [www.pray4everyhome.com](http://www.pray4everyhome.com) with any other institution. Residential information is strictly used to map neighbors from openly public records in order to create prayer lists. No data collected on our site is shared or sold.

### **Where does the prayer list data come from?**

All data we share on this site is “white pages” level information which is publicly available or self-reported. All site users must agree to use their lists for ministry purposes only. **Mapping Center for Evangelism and Church Growth** is a partner in this effort and is the “engine” behind created the neighborhood prayer lists.

### **How is my prayer list created?.**

The prayer walking data is probable based on your supplied address and available geo-coding data of mail delivery locations. Instances where mail is not received at a home (such as PO Box use) will affect some lists.

### **Will my neighbors know I’m praying for them?**

Not unless you talk with them and ask if they have specific prayer needs. No notice is generated by volunteering to pray over your neighborhood. All data is publicly available and includes no information from private sources.

### **If I submit a prayer request via the Home page, where does it go?**

Prayer requests sent anonymously will be distributed to prayer volunteers through social platforms and emails. For example, “Please pray for my son who will leave for college soon. He is not a believer.” Prayer requests submitted with a desire for contact will be privately emailed to a qualified missionary for confidential follow-up. The prayer need itself may be shared without contact information to additional prayer volunteers to pray over.

### **Who answers the 888-Jesus20 phone number?**

This number will connect to trained volunteers at North American Mission Board Evangelism Response Center. Volunteers are available 24/7.

### **Who can participate?**

Anyone who shares a genuine desire to pray as part of an evangelism effort based on personal belief in Jesus Christ as Lord. Registration includes steps for a member of a participating church or an individual who shares their beliefs and is subsequently activated by a site administrator.
