WORSHIP ARTS CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

*Worship Arts Classes will meet daily for 1 hour during camp.
All Worship Arts will be incorporated into Friday Night's Worship Concert.*

Chimes – Children will learn a song using tone chimes which will join with other instruments to play a prelude at Friday night's worship concert.

Set Design – Children will learn basics about set design and will help build the set for Friday night's worship concert.

Bucket Drumming – Children will learn percussion skills and present a song using those percussion skills.

Drama – Children will utilize acting skills and will learn the drama that goes with the musical for Friday night's Worship Concert. They will be expected to memorize their part and perform the drama on Friday night.

Boompipes – Similar to boomwhackers, but on a much larger scale! Boompipes are large PVC pipes that make a LOUD sound when hit on the floor. Children will learn a piece of music in which they will play Boompipes

Puppets – Children will learn basic puppeteer skills and will learn to perform a skit using hand puppets.

Blacklights – a combination of creative storytelling and song interpretation using blacklights and other props.

Art – Children will learn to use visual arts like painting, drawing, and creating as an expression of worship.

Creative Movement – Children will learn choreography to communicate the message of a song.

Graphic Design – Children will learn how graphics can be used to enhance a worship experience and will work on a project to be used in Friday night's Worship Concert.

Songwriting – Children will be given the opportunity to create a song and will be encouraged in their creative desires and abilities to write a song. Children will be given tips and tools to help them in songwriting.

Guitar – Children will be taught basic guitar skills and will learn a song using those skills; no prior experience needed; guitars will be provided by our camp.

Keyboard – Children will learn basic skills in keyboarding and will be able to play a piece of music with a group of other keyboarding students at the end of the week; **at least 1 year of piano experience is required.**

Photography – Children will learn basic photography skills and will spend the week photographing different aspects of camp. They will use the pictures they take to put together a project to be presented at Friday night's worship concert. **Children will need a camera with SD card or a device with photo capabilities.**

Videography – Children will learn skills in videography and will work with the camp's media director to create an end of the week flashback video to show at Friday night's worship concert. **Children will need a camera with SD card or a device with video capabilities.**
