After many hours of flying, I arrived in Dakar, Senegal. The following morning, ten of us traveled in a very small car with no air conditioning. It was 102 degrees and an all day trip to the city of Ziginchor. I awoke early the following morning to find 16 pastors, all new believers, waiting for me to teach them. Because I had little time to prepare and almost no rest, I felt overwhelmed. However, when I opened my mouth, God poured out His message for two solid days.
